Responsibilities and Experience

Tim is a senior road safety auditor who has undertaken a large number of existing conditions, design and traffic management road safety audits, as well as heavy vehicle route assessments.

Either individually or as part of a road safety audit team, he has been involved with:

- A detailed design road safety audit of the upgrade of James Congdon Drive.
- A concept design road safety audit for contra flow bicycle lanes within Adelaide CBD.
- Concept design road safety audits for the New Royal Adelaide Hospital.

Examples of more significant projects for which Tim has provided road safety audit services are:

- Northern Expressway – Detailed Design and Traffic Management
- Southern Expressway Duplication – Design, Pre-Opening, Post-Opening and Traffic Management
- North – South Connector (PRExy to Regency Road) – Concept Design and Traffic Management

Further projects that Tim has been heavily involved with include:

- Detailed design of the junction upgrade of Sullivans Drive and Lincoln Highway, Port Lincoln.
- Assisted with the 2020 Transport Plan for the Southern and Hills Local Government Association.
- A heavy vehicle route assessment for L2A vehicles to access Lobethal in the Adelaide Hills.

In 2016 Tim worked in the AECOM London office traffic team on the London Borough of Southwark framework. He focused on cycling projects, including developing concepts for several of the Quietways projects and the Southwark Spine. His main focus was the outline design of the 'Southwark Spine' cycling route. The route is a north-south corridor throughout the borough which aims to complement the existing cycle network and provide a safe quiet option for local trips, particularly for families.

In the early part of 2017 Tim undertook a short term contract for Jacobs in the central London office with a focus on traffic engineering, early concept design and funding bids.
